

2010 Show Rules and Regulation

1. Entries must be postmarked no later than midnight, December 16th, 2009. NO PHONE ENTRIES.
2. Entry Fees are \$3.50 per bird, except Show Rollers are \$4.50 per bird. (make checks payable to: **St. Louis Metropolitan Pigeon Fanciers Association Inc.**)
3. Seamless bands of all reputable banding organizations will be recognized.
4. All birds must be cooped by 9:00 am Saturday. Judging will start at 9:30 a.m. Birds may be cooped Friday from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. EXCEPTION: Show Rollers judging will begin Friday evening, See Show Rollers information for details.
5. The St. Louis Club will provide Champion trophies for any breed where there are 15 or more entries by at least two exhibitors. Reserve Champion trophies for any breed where there are 25 or more entries by at least two exhibitors. EXCEPTION: See Specialty Clubs.
6. Specialty Club having one hundred or more entries will receive a one dollar rebate for each bird entered. However, once a specialty Club qualifies for the one dollar rebate the St. Louis Club will not provide any awards. It will be the responsibility of the Specialty Club to provide any and all awards.
7. The St. Louis Metropolitan Pigeon Fanciers Association is not responsible for the loss of any birds, but will take all precautions to prevent such losses.
8. Sale birds will not be allowed in the show hall unless bird(s) are entered in the show for exhibition.
9. All trophies/plaques and awards will be listed the day of the show.
10. Refreshments will be available for purchase on Friday evening and throughout the day on Saturday. Coffee and donuts will be available for purchase on Saturday morning and in the afternoon a catered lunch will be served at a nominal cost.
